Chris Manegold, Chief Executive Officer, Economic Development Alliance of Southern Ohio, met with the commissioners to file amendments to the agreements for Georgia M-H, LLC and Vitatoe Industries.

Mr. Manegold said that the construction projects for both companies ran behind schedule making the effective dates on the abatements incorrect. If this would go unnoticed for some time, it could have created some trouble for the companies.

Mr. Neal said that we don't want someone making an issue of it three years down the road. Then we would really have a mess on our hands.

Mr. Manegold said that this is a business friendly thing to do. The investment commitments at both companies have already been met. I would like to express my appreciation to the Board for working with companies in situations like this.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTED – CERTIFY FUNDS ROSS COUNTY SENIOR CITIZENS TAX LEVY**

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-114  
RESOLUTION REQUESTING CERTIFICATION  
OF COUNTY AUDITOR  
(REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.03(B))**

**WHEREAS**, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Ross County, Ohio, and it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Ross County, Ohio, two thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy an existing 0.50 mill levy in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Ross County, Ohio for the purpose of providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities, pursuant to Section 307.694 or 307.85 of the Ohio Revised Code, at a rate not exceeding five-tenths (0.50) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$.05) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for a period of five years commencing with the current tax year 2017, and, be it further




**RESOLVED**, that the Clerk of this Board of Commissioners, Gail L. Stout, be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Ross County Auditor; and, be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Ross County Auditor certify to the Board of Commissioners the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated by a total 0.50 mill levy.

Sections 5705.191 and Section 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code authorize the submission of this tax to the elector.




Our 2017-2018 Program Enhancements include Mobile Medical Equipment coverage \$250,000; Privacy or Security Event, previously Cyber Security Event, Privacy response expense coverage broadened to include the theft of private information from paper files, in addition to electronic files; Personal Card Industry-Data Security Standards (PCI-DSS) Assessment coverage \$250,000; Drone liability coverage; Reimbursement program for psychological testing, American Corrections Accreditation for county jails and Simulator training for law enforcement and corrections.
