


**RESOLUTION ADOPTED – ROSS COUNTY COALITION AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

Mr. Garrett moved the adoption of the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 17-143**

**WHEREAS**, Section 3113.34 of the Ohio Revised Code provides the mechanism for additional marriage license issuance fees and divorce filing fees to be collected, deposited in a special fund and expended to provide financial assistance to shelters for victims of domestic violence; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3113.35(A) of the Revised Code provides for a shelter for victims of domestic violence to apply to the board of county commissioners for the release of funds to be collected as fees for the issuance of marriage licenses pursuant to ORC Section 3113.34, or fees collected as additional costs in annulment, divorce or dissolution of marriage actions and proceedings pursuant to division (D) of Section 2303.201 of the Revised Code, and that are to be used for the funding of the shelter; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 18, 2017, the Ross County Board of Commissioners did receive an application from the Ross County Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Chillicothe, Ohio, for the release of funds collected in Ross County pursuant to Section 3113.34 of the Revised Code during calendar year 2017, to be used for funding its operations; and




**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, has reviewed the qualifications for funding set forth in Section 3113.36 of the Revised Code for a shelter for victims of domestic violence, and the criteria established in ORC Section 3113.38 and the application of priorities set forth therein to be considered as the basis for allocation of funds among shelters; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners of Ross County, Ohio, hereby approves the application of the Ross County Coalition Against Domestic Violence to receive said funds to be collected in Ross County during the year 2017; and, be it further

**RESOLVED**, that these funds estimated to total \$18,000.00, be paid twice annually to the Ross County Coalition Against Domestic Violence according to the following schedule: Actual funds collected from the first day of January through the thirtieth day of June, 2017, shall be disbursed to the shelter by the fifteenth day of July, 2018, and actual funds collected from the first day of July through the thirty-first day of December, 2017, shall be disbursed to the shelter by the fifteenth day of January, 2018.




**RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby approves the attached Agreement reached between the Ross County Sheriff and the Union for the Blue Unit.



