FINAL RESOLUTION 17-135

The following Final Resolution enacted by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Ross, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, on 2nd day of October 2017, the LPA enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

The project consists of improvements to Charleston Pike (C.R. 222) from S.L.M. 4.39 to S.L.M. 4.6 and the rehabilitation of Bridge No. ROS C.R. 222 - 3.83 (SFN 7146116) over CSX railroad including guardrail, upgrades, vandal protection fencing, concrete piles, abutments and bridge decks, erosion control upgrades, drainage upgrades, asphalt concrete surfacing, curb, and pavement markings, lying within Ross County; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The County agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement, less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation.

The share of the cost of the LPA is now estimated in the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,974,773.00) LESS SIB LOAN in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$800,000.00) leaving a balance of Two Million One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,174,773.00), but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the LPA's ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of the same to this legislative authority; and WHEREAS, The LPA desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved:

That the estimated sum, of Two Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,974,773.00) LESS SIB LOAN in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$800,000.00) leaving a balance of Two Million One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,174,773.00) is hereby appropriated for the improvement described above and the fiscal officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order on the treasurer for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. We hereby agree to assume in the first instance, the share of the cost and expense over and above the amount to be paid from Federal funds.

That the LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

III. That the LPA enter into a contract with the State, and that the Ross County

Engineer be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract, providing for the payment of the LPA the sum of money set forth herein above for improving the described project.'

IV. That the LPA transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this resolution

CONTRACT AGREEMENT STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CHARLESTON PIKE BRIDGE

The work to be performed under this contract shall consist of the following:

The project consists of improvements to Charleston Pike (C.R. 222) from S.L.M. 4.39 to S.L.M. 4.6 and the rehabilitation of Bridge No. ROS C.R. 222 - 3.83 (SFN 7146116) over CSX railroad including guardrail, upgrades, vandal protection fencing, concrete piles, abutments and bridge decks, erosion control upgrades, drainage upgrades, asphalt concrete surfacing, curb, and pavement markings, lying within Ross County.

The LPA agrees to pay to the STATE its share of the total estimated cost expense for the above highway project in the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,974,773.00} LESS SIB LOAN in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, (\$800,000.00} leaving a balance of Two Million One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three and 00/100 Dollars, (\$2,174,773.00}.
