SUBJECTS BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD

Sharlene Kibbey, Ross County resident, Waneta Wellinghoff, Ross County Chief Dog Warden, met with the commissioners to file a complaint on a county employee with the dog warden’s office.

Ms. Kibbey said that she wants to file a complaint on Lloyd Caldwell, deputy dog warden concerning his rude attitude towards her son. My son had a dog go under a car in his driveway for shade and wrapped his choker chain around the bumper of the car and choked himself. Ms. Kibbey’s son was in the process of burying the dog when Mr. Caldwell arrived. He ask to see the dog and ask the gentleman for identification. He responded that he had not been charged with a crime. At that time Mr. Caldwell called the sheriff and had the gentleman arrested for obstruction of official business. Mr. Caldwell also took the other three dogs from the property to impound because each dog had no dog tag. The sheriff only summoned the gentleman and no arrest was filed. However, the Dog Warden’s office filed animal crudity against owners. They were able to get the doges back once the tags were paid for and shots administered. Before the arrest/summons, my son ask if they could purchase tags from the deputy dog warden and Mr. Caldwell indicated “NO”. My complaint is that Mr. Caldwell dealing with the public. I posted on social media if anyone else had had run ins with Lloyd Caldwell and I received 30+ comments. No one had anything good to say about him. My son and girlfriend have written statements of what happened and I forgot to bring them today.

Ms. Wellinghoff presented pictures and Mr. Caldwell’s written report of the incident.

Mr. Corcoran said that we will need to speak to Mr. Caldwell and get his side of the story. In the meantime, could you bring us the written statements from your son and girlfriend? Once we receive everything then we can set down with Mr. Caldwell and discuss the situation.

Paul Minney, Emergency Management Agency director, held a virtual meeting with the commissioners to discuss the reception of a communication trailer and decontamination trailer from the Southeast Sector.

Mr. Minney said that the decontamination trailer would be housed at Union Township Fire Department garage located on Pleasant Valley Road. This trailer was purchased for \$49,000 with grant money and will be given to us. The trailer will be stocked by the Southeast Sector.

Mr. Corcoran asked if Union Township is ok in housing this trailer. Are the titles in our name? We will need the titles changed to be able to insure them.

Mr. Minney said that the communication trailer was housed in Jackson County and the building was hit by lighting. We will also house this trailer in Ross County. Still looking for a location. The communication trailer is used for eleven (11) different counties within Southeast Ohio.

Mr. Corcoran said get the titles to Brad and we then can have them placed in our names to get them covered with insurance.

OTHER BUSINESS

Judi Mannion, CEBCO Wellness coordinator, met with the commissioners to discuss additional on-line health screening for the 2020 Wellness program.


Jeff Marks, prosecuting attorney, met with the commissioners to discuss the dog licensing contract credit card data. Tom Spetnagel Jr., county auditor was also present for this meeting. Mr. Marks wanted to know if the date was a security site to purchase online dog tags. Mr. Spetnagel Jr. assured the prosecutor that indeed it was a secure site. Our office currently uses Fairfield Computer Services, LLC for the issuance of dog tags and have no complaints.


