## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Bids shall be submitted electronically through the Bid Express® service at [www.bidexpress.com](http://www.bidexpress.com) until **11:30 a.m.** local time on **Wednesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, and the same will be publicly opened at the same hour at the office of the Ross County Engineer, 755 Fairgrounds Road, Chillicothe, Ohio 45601 for the equipment, labor, and materials necessary to complete the **Superstructure Portion only** of the **BRIDGE PROJECT** known as:

### **PID 117612 ROS-CR184-3.76 SUPERSTRUCTURE ONLY** (Rozelle Creek Road)

**Project Description:** This project consists of the replacement of the existing single span steel beam bridge with reinforced concrete deck and asphalt concrete wearing course, supported on reinforced concrete substructure; with a single span galvanized steel beam with corrugated metal decking bridge, supported on the Engineer prepared existing reinforced concrete substructure. The proposed structure shall be furnished and installed ASTM A572 galvanized or approved equivalent, including but not limited to the beams, diaphragms, guardrail posts and supports, attachment angles, and incidentals in conformance to the Engineer's provided plans.

The **SBE Goal** for this bridge project = **8%**

Project plans and bid documents are located on the web service [www.bidexpress.com](http://www.bidexpress.com). Bid proposals must contain the name of every person interested therein and shall be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond for the full amount of bid; or in lieu of the bid guaranty and contract bond, the bidder may submit a bid guaranty as provided by Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code in the form of a certified check or cashier's check. The amount of the certified check or cashier's check shall be equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid. The certified check or cashier's check submitted with a bid will be held as a guarantee on an accepted bid proposal.

This notice is also posted on the Ross County Commissioners website, which may be accessed at <http://www.rosscountyohio.gov/commissioners/notices.html>. On the website, click the link "Public Notices" and then click on the appropriate "Legal Notice" for this project.

Bidders are required to be **PRE-QUALIFIED WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** to submit a bid for this project.

Prevailing wage rates, as determined by the Federal Department of Labor, will apply to this project in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Wage Act.

It is anticipated the contract will be awarded within 7 days of the bid opening date. At that time, a bid guaranty and contract bond in the sum of 100% of the bid shall be executed in accordance with Section 307.89 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All qualified business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and no bidder will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in awarding the subject contract.

Certified Check or Cashier's Check will be returned to all other bidders after the Contract has been awarded.

The bidder's address shall be included along with his/her signature on the bid.

A preconstruction meeting will be held at least 10 days before the beginning of construction. **On-site contract construction work shall not commence on this project before June 21, 2027 and the contract completion date is July 16, 2027.** Upon failure to complete the work within the time specified, the Contractor shall be governed in accordance with Section 5555.67 of the Ohio Revised Code. No proposal shall be considered unless it complies with all the rules and regulations set forth in the Contract documents. All bidders are urged to carefully read the same and comply with them. The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
