**AMENDMENT TO ARCHITECHTURAL AGREEMENT ATHENS SOUTHEAST OHIO HISTORY CENTER**

The Basic Services fees to be paid to the Architect are increased by \$5,850.00 for the design and construction administration costs related to the interior renovations of the first floor stage and interior ramp as described in Exhibit A. The scope of work outlined in Exhibit A of this Amendment is incorporated in the scope of work outlined in Section 1.1.1 of the Agreement to the extent the terms of Exhibit A are not inconsistent with the Agreement. The Reimbursable Expenses to be paid to the Architect are increased by \$6,200.00 for the subsurface exploration and geotechnical engineering services described in Exhibit B. The total amount of Basic Services fees, as revised by this Amendment, payable to the Architect under this Agreement shall not exceed \$130,774.00, which includes the revised total Reimbursable Expenses, payable to the Architect under Paragraph 11.8 of the Agreement.

**RESOLUTION 013-25**  
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF**  
**CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY, DESIGNATED ROSS COUNTY AUDITOR’S**  
**PARCEL NO. 370908049000, THE EXECUTION OF ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS ANCILLARY THERETO, AND**  
**APPROPRIATING FUNDS NECESSARY**  
**TO CONSUMMATE THE PURCHASE OF SUCH REAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Ross County, Ohio (the “County”) is empowered by Ohio law, including but not limited to R.C. 307.08 and 307.081, to purchase real property;

**WHEREAS**, the County is further empowered by Ohio law, including but not limited to R.C. 307.09 and 307.10, to lease real property the County owns;

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to purchase certain real property within the unincorporated territory of the County, located at 1498 Stone Road, LLC and designated Ross County Auditor’s Parcel No. 370908049000 (the “Property”), for the total sum of \$267,127.50 inclusive of closing costs (the “Purchase Price”);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to a certain Right of First Refusal for the benefit of the County with respect to the Property, dated January 29, 2018 and recorded in the official records of the Ross County, Ohio Recorder at Book 517, Page 1324 (the “ROFR”), the current owner of the Property (the “Seller”) notified the County of the Seller’s receipt of a bona fide third-party offer to purchase the Property;

**WHEREAS**, to the County elected to exercise its rights under the ROFR to acquire the Property;

**WHEREAS**, the terms and conditions governing the County’s proposed purchase of the Property are set forth in the Assignment and Assumption of Real Estate Purchase Agreement attached as Exhibit 1 to this Resolution;

**WHEREAS**, the Property is currently subject to a certain lease agreement, dated November 14, 2014, and extended by letter dated October 18, 2024 for a period of five (5) years commencing on November 13, 2024 and ending on November 12, 2029, whereby the Seller leases the Property to Ohio Medical Transportation, Inc. d/b/a MedFlight for critical care aviation medical transport purposes (the “Lease”);

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to maintain the Lease of the Property to MedFlight, and serve as lessor following the County’s purchase of the Property, according to the existing Lease terms and conditions;

**WHEREAS**, the terms and conditions governing assignment of the Lease to, and assumption of the Lease by, the County are set forth in the Assignment and Assumption of Lease attached as Exhibit 2 to this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, certain other structures on the Property are currently occupied by TRM Avionics Logistics, Ltd., and the parties wish to formally continue that occupancy substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Lease Agreement attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 3;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the terms and conditions respectively set forth in the Assignment and Assumption of Real Estate Purchase Agreement, the Assignment and Assumption of Lease, and the Lease Agreement are fair and reasonable, and it is in the best interests of the County to proceed with the County’s acquisition of the Property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Ross County, Ohio:

Section 1. The County hereby appropriates \$267,500.00 from the Capital Improvements Account, account code 100-01-03-7204, for the purpose of paying the Purchase Price and associated closing costs to consummate the County’s purchase of the Property.

Section 2. The Board President is hereby authorized to execute, on the County’s behalf, the Assignment and Assumption of Real Estate Purchase Agreement in substantially the same form and upon substantially the same terms as the attached Exhibit 1.

Section 3. The Board President is hereby authorized to execute, on the County’s behalf, the Assignment and Assumption of Lease in substantially the same form and upon substantially the same terms as the attached Exhibit 2.

Section 4. The Board President is hereby authorized to execute, on the County’s behalf, the Assignment and Assumption of Lease in substantially the same form and upon substantially the same terms as the attached Exhibit 3.

Section 5. The Board President is further authorized to execute any and all additional instruments or documentation, and take any other actions, on the County’s behalf, as may be necessary or appropriate to consummate the County’s purchase and acquisition of the Property upon such terms as are consistent with this Resolution and in the best interests of the County.

Section 6. The County hereby ratifies any and all prior action taken and/or authorized to date by the County Administrator or legal counsel acting on the County’s behalf in an effort to secure the County’s acquisition of the Property.

Section 7. It is found that all formal actions of the Board of County Commissioners concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 121 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 8. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


**Staff Meeting was held**


**ADJOURN**


