### ROSS COUNTY SHOEMAKER AIRPORT 2024 GRANT APPLICATION REHAB RUNWAY 5/23 CONSTRUCT RUNWAY 23 BLAST PAD

**Nicole Wells, Metro Housing and David Tillis, Lucy House** gave the Commissioners the recently reduced price for the strip of land that is for sale by Metropolitan Housing, behind the Lucy House, \$15,000.00. The Commissioners will discuss this and have a decision by the next meeting 7/8/2024.
